








French post offices in the India Settlements first opened in 1853/54. Prior to that, French mail, like the letter below from St. Denis, Réunion to a ship merchant in Nantes, used a British PO located in Pondichéry and nearby Madras. The letter probably traveled to India via the British Screw Steamship out of Mauritius to Madras. • THE FIRST USE OF POSTAGE STAMPS


Although offered use of French stamps, the **French Indian** Settlements refused to use them. They feared this would antagonize the British who were the predominant colonial power in the Indian Subcontinent.



First Day of Eagle Use: 22 Fevr 1860. 10C "décime de mer" rate was only for mail to Mauritius. The destinee would then be expected to pay the 6 pence Mauritius inland fee.

1864 letter from Pondichéry to Nantes via French mail packet. The 60C franking is of particular interest due to the inclusion of a 10C "Aigle couché", or Eagle lying sideways, pair. This is found in 3 plate positions per galvano for a total of 6 per pane of 360 stamps. It is not at all common on cover.



E FRENCH COLONIAL GENERAL ISSUE

French India





1868 1.20F rate cover to London via Suez and Marseille. Mail to England is scarce, as is use of the INDE lozenge on Eagle stamps (began 1868). The 81point mute lozenge is much more common.




Cover to same London address with same 1.20 Eagle franking tied by more common 81 point lozenge sold for \$2300 in the Siegel Raymond Vogel auction of 2010. The foreign letter rate from French India is very rare.


Maritime Mail

Letter posted at dockside. Line O ran from Calcutta to Ceylon with a stop in Pondichéry, then via Suez and Marseille. French stamps were required but colonial stamps were tolerated in colonial ports. The anchor lozenge was Used prior to 1876. Double rate letter $(2 \times 60C)$,



PONDICHERY (LINE O): Dec. 9, 1869. This rare double weight cover to Bordeaux was osted at dockside in Pondichery and sent by the Line O French mail packet. Line O raveled between Calcutta and Colombo, Ceylon with interval ports of call at Madras and Pondichery. Note stamps are tied by the anchor lozenge. (Salles 1.962).







French entry mark on 40C Eagle posted in Pondichery. Stamps rarely tied by French entry marks. Salles 1.882.



PONDICHERY: June 14, 1872. French packet rate cover to Marseille. The franking consists of two 30C Napoleon III stamps of the second issue tied by the small 8x8 dot mute lozenge. Salles 1.854 maritime entry mark is struck in reddish brown


1872 60C rate folded letter to France. Franking composed of 2 copies of the 30C Napoleon III stamp tied by the 81 point mute lozenge of Pondichéry. Oddly Napoleon's visage first appeared in the colonies in 1871, after he was deposed in the Franco-Prussian war and the Third Republic was declared.

GI Issues of 1871-72

1872 60C French mail packet rate cover to Marseille. In 1871 the Eagle stamps were replaced by the imperforate Empire and Ceres types. The scarce 20C and more common 40C light orange stamps are both tied by faint INDE lozenges.







Eagle printed matter frankings are extremely rare.



Military Mail

Reduced rate military mail was available for those few French troops stationed in Pondichéry. The top Eagle cover of 1869 exhibits the 20C rate to France. In 1872, the rate was increased to 25C and the lower cover demonstrates franking by a single 25C Ceres stamp of the 1872-76 issue. Clear octagonal Corr. d'Armées strikes confirm military origin. These very rare covers were lifted from Florent Tricot's wonderful French Colonies military mail web site.

Mahé: 1866 British India post office cover to Bordeaux. Strip of 4 x 4 anna India postage stamps tied by unique lozenge of the Mahé British India PO. Both British and French mail service was available in all the French enclaves. Overseas postage to France and colonies usually went through the French PO.

Mahé: 6 January 1867. Letter to Nantes via French mail packet. The 60C rate is composed of a pair of 10C and single 40C Eagles. One of only 2-3 Mahé Eagle covers known to exist. Offered in Lugdunum VO of Dec. 2018 with start of € 7,000.

Mahé: 3 November 1868. Letter to Fontenay-le-Comte via French mail packet. The 60C rate is composed of a pair of 10C Eagles and single 40C Eagle. One of only 3 Mahé Eagle covers are known to exist. Scan from Chauvet.

Mahé 1866 20C military rate cover to Bordeaux. Mahé had no French mail packet service, hence no authorized military mail and no octagonal corr. d'armées cachet. Nevertheless, the reduced military rate was accepted and the civilian Mahé cds was applied. On reverse "lettre de Mr Granger chirugien de marine impériale". From web site of Florent Tricot, ex-Millet.

Mahé to Macon, France 1875 single weight letter via French mail packet service. The 60C rate is composed of 4 copies of the 15C Ceres (Yvert #22). Sold Dec. 1998 in Jamet Baudot VO for 17,888 FF. vs starting bid of 7,000 FF.

Mahé to Macon, France 1875 single weight letter. Spectacular triple color 1.20 F British packet rate through Brindisi. The additional 0.40 F was collected to pay for inland Italian postage. Rate existed from 1871 to 1876.

A closer look at a letter from Mahé to Mâcon, the Mme. Duttroya correspondence of 1875. Striking red mute lozenges and red CDS make these covers most striking. (Chauvet scan).



This very rare item was offered in the Roumet VO of 9 Oct. 2001 with a lofty starting price of 20,000 FF (\$2800). The use of French stamps in the colonies was not authorized except in rare cases of colonial stamp shortages.



Mahé: 30 Dec 1889 letter to Paris. Very rare franking composed of strip of 5 perforated 5C Sage stamps of France. Was there a shortage of Alphée Dubois colonials in French India in 1889?





CHANDERNAGORE: 26/10/1864 lettter to Gironde, France. Although 70C of French Empire Eagle stamps appear on the cover, it was mistakenly placed in the British Chandernagore PO and went unpaid, thus the stamps were not canceled locally or on arrival. Since the British mail packet rate was 80 centimes, it received a manuscript "9" on arrival, "8" décimes for postage and "1" décime penalty. Item offered by Cérès Philately at a net price of € 5,000, Summer 2020. 1 of 2 known Eagle covers from Chandernagore.



Chandernagor: 18 Dec 1874 letter to France. The 1.20 FF rate composed of copies of Yvert 10 and 13. Basic British packet rate via Brindisi and Modana in effect from 1/1/1871 to the advent of the UPU in 1876. Neat blue double fleuron CDS, PD and INDE lozenge tying the stamps, confirming use of the INDE strike prior to the boxed lozenge. Scan from Chauvet.





Two of the 5 known letters canceled with the very rare boxed lozenge of Chandernagore, including the first day of use of the new UPU 40C overseas rate (7/1/1876). Note that all 5 such covers are displayed in this presentation, in addition to a detached stamp from my collection.

THE FRENCH COLONIAL GENERAL ISSUE French India 1885-91



Chandernagor: The Dubois Issue of 1881.

CHANDERNAGOR to Paris; 22 Sept 1885. On May 15, 1879, the basic rate for overseas mail declined from 35 to 25C for letters up to 10 grams. Although most mail from the Etablissements Francais de l'Inde were sent from the largest settlement of Pondichery, mail from the other settlements of Chandernagor, Karikal, Yanoan and Mahe are scarce to very rare during the General Issue period. This cover displays Yvert #53 of the 1881 Dubois issue with a SON Chandernagor cancel.



Chandernagore. 22 Sept 1885 letter to Paris. The basic rate dropped from 35C to 25C per 10 grams on Feb. 16, 1879.



Chandernagore: 1888 5C imprimé rate on newsprint band to Paris. Well struck blue INDE/CHANDERNAGORE/16 JUIN 88 CDS sent to Paris. This is the only imprimé rate item I have seen outside of Pondichéry





Opened Eagle letter offered by Behr. The 60C French packet rate is composed of copies of 4 and 5. The 20C was added for "aesthetic reasons" and is marked with an "X". Stone lists first day of Eagle use in Karikal as 18 Jan 1865. Only 3 Eagle covers from Karikal known.







Karikal: 2 Mai 1870 folded letter to Aurillac, France. 60C French packet rate composed of a pair of Yvert #3 and a single copy of #5. Stamps tied by INDE lozenge. Karikal: 15 Avril 71 circuit court letter to France. 1 F 20 Voie de Brindisi rate to France. One of 3 known Eagle covers. Both mute and INDE lozenges were in use in Karikal. Ex-Alain Millet cover.

The Karikal INDE lozenge was used long after it was withdrawn from other colonial POs (1876) and it still gave a very sharp impression well into the mid 1880s likely due to its infrequent use.

Karikal printed matter rate "carte de visite" letter to Nouméa, New Caledonia (very rare origin and destination!). The 5C Alphée Dubois stamp is tied by the unique boxed Karikal lozenge. The mid December CDS suggests Christmas or New Years greetings.





Karikal to Algiers c1900 illustrated postcard from a Madras merchant. The 10C Navigation and Commerce franking tied by the distinctive boxed INDE lozenge of 1893.
