Ditto envelope so mailed by UN post office.clerk.(*) U.S. envelope with Indian airmail label, (went through without state but only zip number).

Please return any of these that do not fit into your collection or that are redundant. If you want only one Ambulant postal card, please keep the one from Altstatten, and return the others, which have other, separate interests, such as Musicday and UPU and maroon Stamp instead of green. I mean if Ambulant is your sole interest; for their souvenir value is much greater.

The Bermuda 1s3d is the one with the Sandys corrected, i.e. without apostrophe after the y. The Besant stamp should have 1847. Also enclosed are the two Bodhisattva positions: the one with the arm outstretched your right side is the error; and the misolaced I.E.F. overprint. The last is believed to have considerable error value, though not listed in Gibbons.
