Note to Users

Editors Rich and Stone (Whole nos. 19-98 and 118-146) included in the Philatelist numerous short notes, comments, photos of stamps or covers, and occasionally clippings from other publications. Although the subjects of these notes are of general interest, the contents by their brevity are not usually conclusive reference sources. Advanced collectors and researchers may be disappointed in such items. Most of these, as well as passing mentions within longer articles, have been indexed and are coded "n". Occasionally there may be two such briefs in a single issue, requiring a careful reading of the whole number cited to locate them.

Generally the editors shunned long, serialized articles. The usual articles, informative for general collectors, seldom cover a topic exhaustively. There is also much material in them which is useful to specialized collectors who recognize that more recent discoveries might require some amplification of statements made. Items which we believe are still materially correct and substantial in content are marked "++".

Notes or articles which were reprinted or abstracted from other sources are marked "r".
